Dear Pastor and Church Family,

The very first church we started on the mission field was in Tororo, Uganda. After we were there for a couple of years a delegation of men from the village of Butege road bicycles over 40 miles to ask us to start a church in their village. They came several times and after much prayer we sent Medad to begin a church in that area. A short time later Medad came to me about one of his teenagers who was suffering from tuberculosis. His family spent all they had and the doctors gave him a slim chance of recovery. We prayed for him, found better doctors and assisted with getting him the proper medications and praise the Lord, he completely recovered.

That young man, Michael, began not only to recover, but also grew in the Lord. He surrendered to preach the Gospel and attended our Bible Institute. Later he helped us in a new church we began in southern Uganda during our second term. Michael is one of the most talented men we have ever trained in Uganda. He later became the Pastor of that church. Sadly, Michael's life took a horrible turn as he became addicted to alcohol. He was immediately removed from the pastorate and after giving up hope, his wife divorced him.

Here is his testimony that he just sent me, "I thank God for the revival in my life, the continuous prayers from Pastor Myers family, many forsook and denied me, but some continued praying for me. Through the support and encouragement of my new community, church, and Pastor Myers, I began to find hope and healing. I slowly began to rebuild my life, and my relationships began to flourish. I discovered a new sense of purpose and passion for serving others...Today, I'm grateful to be serving in ministry, using my experiences to help others who may be struggling. My village has seen a positive impact as I've shared my story and the message of hope with others. I've seen lives changed, and I'm humbled to be a part..."

Although he is disqualified to pastor, he is working with children's ministries that he started in the village of Butege. The children come for after-school Bible Studies and he frequently preaches in local schools. Recently in the school to the right he had 27 students saved! We are thankful that the Lord can and still uses men who repent and get back to seeing souls saved. Just another example of "Fruit that Remains" in your giving to reaching souls in Uganda and South Africa.
